<b>Dust</b>	Likely - 3	Critical/serious - 3 COPD, asthma, allergies	3 x 3  9	Use the correct mask. Cut at the right time in relation to cleaning/ fur. Generally good cleaning in the barn	1 x 2  2
<b>Ergonomics</b>	Slightly likely - 2	Critical/serious - 3	2 x 6  6	Switch positions, job variations, think of workloads in relation to load. Quality of the cutting equipment and the weight	1 x 1  2
<b>Animals</b>	Likely - 3	Critical/serious - 3 Pinch, push, kick	3 x 3  9	Knowledge of the animals and their reaction pattern. Use a fence. Good footwear	2 x 3  6
<b>Power cords</b>	Likely - 3	Dangerous - 2 Troubled animals, own fall, broken equipment	3 x 2  6	Battery machine, low weight, take a break. Automatic cable winch	2 x 2  4
<b>Hearing</b>	Slightly likely - 2	Not dangerous - 1	2 x 1  2	Use hearing protection - evaluate against risk as it may impair other hearing impulses	2 x 1  2
